Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop in the beginning hiring 4 people. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty workers and their annual sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Today, Cascade is one of the leading international manufacturers within the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. Throughout the final sixty years, the industry of material handling has grown into a very advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade presently continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck attachments and numerous associated items. The business feels certain in their capability so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was constructed in the year 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total staff reached 180 staff and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

The next production plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are made worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in blades.
